

Public feedback sought on proposed safety improvements on Route 11

As part of the Potsdam Route 11 active transport improvement study, public feedback is being sought on a series of possible identified improvements along the Route 11 corridor, between downtown and Walmart.

Over the past nine months, the Clarkson Construction Engineering Management Consulting Group (C3G) has been working in conjunction with the St. Lawrence County Health Initiative, as well as the Village and Town of Potsdam, to develop a concept plan for active transportation and traffic improvements along the Route 11 corridor from Clarkson University to Walmart. A walkability survey, as well as multiple public input sessions, have helped produce potential solutions to promote safe transportation for all.
