Deputy Mayor Warr opened the hearing at 4:20 p.m. He stated that this public hearing is to receive public comments on a proposed Local Law to amend Chapter 168 Vehicles and Traffic, Article X Schedules, Section 168-69 Parking Prohibited at all times to extend the no parking zone on the South side of Main Street to the Village line.

Village Clerk, Lori Queor, then read the Legal Notice as published.

Deputy Mayor Warr stated that he did not see where this request would benefit the taxpayers. He stated that events that happen at SUNY Potsdam bring people into the restaurants, etc. and although SUNY offers the use of the fields for free they do not offer any parking for the events.

Trustee Goliber agreed with Deputy Mayor Warr's statement.

Trustee Lee agreed with Deputy Mayor Warr also. She stated that she thinks prohibiting parking on just one side creates a greater hazard with people crossing the street with children or strollers. She stated that she felt SUNY needs to manage parking and events better.
