

The Regular Meeting of the Village of Potsdam Board of Trustees was held on Monday, July 15, 2019 at 4:25 P.M., in the Civic Center Board Room, Park Street, Potsdam, New York.

Deputy Mayor Warr opened the meeting at 4:25 P.M., pointed out the exits on the North and East Walls and advised that the board room has the capacity for 109 people.

Motion was made by Trustee Goliber and Seconded by Trustee Lee to accept the minutes as submitted. Deputy Mayor Warr and Trustees Lee & Goliber were in favor – Trustee McKenna abstained - none opposed – motion carried.

Deputy Mayor's comments: The Summer Fest was a success this year despite the storm on Thursday evening.

Trustee's Comments: Trustee McKenna thanked the Fire Department, Village, Chamber of Commerce and all the volunteers who worked on the Summer Festival. She then asked if the public hearings could start at 4:30 and then have our regular meeting follow instead of being scheduled before 4:30. Clerk Queor stated that it can happen if the Mayor would like to have that done and that she will check with him. Trustee Goliber thanked the Fire Department, Police Department and Rescue Squad for the work they did Thursday night after the storm. Trustee Lee agreed that the Summer Festival was great.

Museum Director's Report: Director Mimi VanDeusen stated that she was not prepared to give a report and asked if she could do it the next meeting. Trustee Lee asked if she could answer questions and Ms. VanDeusen stated that she could. Trustee Lee asked about the archeological dig at Meadow East. Ms. VanDeusen stated that they have found some small things that match the era but they are not finding as many artifacts as they had hoped to. Trustee Lee asked about the Sandstone Festival. Ms. VanDeusen stated that unless they could partner with someone else they cannot do it themselves as it is a lot to do. Trustee McKenna asked what the Sandstone Festival was. Ms. VanDeusen stated it was a tour of the 23 historic buildings plus information on the quarries, etc.
